SUMMER VACATION HOMEWORK

Dear Parents and Students,

Summer vacation is a wonderful time to relax, refresh, and explore new horizons. To keep our young learners creatively engaged and connected with their studies, we have carefully designed meaningful activities that blend foundational learning with fun.

Note for Parents: Please gently guide your child to complete their tasks neatly. Encourage independent efforts, daily reading habits, and small acts of responsibility at home.

1. ENGLISH: FUN WITH LETTERS & WORDS

- **Beautiful Cursive Writing:** Complete 1 page of clean cursive handwriting daily in a separate thin four-line notebook (minimum 15 pages in total).
- **Reading Challenge:** Read one simple paragraph from an English storybook daily with the guidance of your parents. Highlight or underline 3 new words every day to improve vocabulary.
- **Creativity Project (A4 Size Sheet):** Create a colourful chart by drawing or pasting pictures of 5 Naming Words (Nouns) for each category: *Person, Place, Animal, and Thing*.
- **Self-Introduction Activity:** Prepare a 5-line spoken introduction about yourself ("My name is...", "I am ___ years old...", "My favourite game is...", etc.) with confident expressions for a classroom show-and-tell activity after the holidays.

2. HINDI (हिन्दी): मात्रा और लेखन का ज्ञान

- **सुलेख अभ्यास:** सुंदर और साफ अक्षरों में प्रतिदिन एक पृष्ठ सुलेख अपनी हिंदी कार्यपुस्तिका (Notebook) में लिखें (कुल 15 पृष्ठ)।
- **वर्णमाला लेखन:** स्वर (अ से अः) और व्यंजन (क से ज्ञ) को अपनी हिंदी कॉपी में दो बार सुंदर-सुंदर अक्षरों में लिखिए।
- **मात्रा और शब्द ज्ञान (A4 Sheet):** बिना मात्रा वाले दो, तीन और चार अक्षरों वाले 5-5 नए शब्द लिखिए और उनके चित्र बनाइए या चिपकाइए।
- **कविता याद करें:** अपनी पाठ्यपुस्तक या किसी भी मनपसंद बाल-कविता को उचित हाव-भाव (Actions) और लय के साथ याद करें।

3. MATHEMATICS: FUN WITH NUMBERS & SHAPES

- **Number Practice:** Write numbers from **1 to 100** and Number Names from **1 to 20** two times neatly in your mathematics notebook.
- **Concept Check (Before, After, Between):** Copy and solve the following fill-ups in your math notebook:

- What comes *before* 19? _____
- What comes *after* 45? _____
- What comes *between* 67 and 69? _____

- **Shapes Craft Activity:** Cut basic geometric shapes (Square, Rectangle, Circle, Triangle) using vibrant coloured origami sheets. Arrange and paste them on an A4 sheet or chart paper to build a creative figure like a **Robot**, a **Train**, or a **House**.

4. ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES (EVS): KNOWING MY WORLD

- **All About Me:** Paste a recent passport-size photograph of yourself in your notebook and write 5 simple sentences detailing your favourite food, toy, colour, sport, and best friend.
- **Our Wonderful Body:** Draw a basic human outline or paste a picture on an A4 sheet, and label 8 primary body parts clearly (Eyes, Ears, Nose, Mouth, Hands, Legs, Shoulders, and Feet).
- **The Magic Words:** Create a decorative wall hanging or chart showing the three golden words: "**PLEASE**", "**THANK YOU**", and "**SORRY**". Make it colourful and artistic!

5. LIFE SKILLS & PRACTICAL LEARNING

- **Little Gardener:** Plant a small seed (such as green gram, mustard, or coriander) in a small pot or a recycled plastic cup. Water it gently every day, watch it sprout, and bring your green plant to school when classes resume!
- **Helping Hands:** Cultivate independence by participating in household chores:
 - Arrange your own toys, books, and shoes back in their correct places.
 - Help set up the dinner table before meals.
- **Hygiene Habits:** Practice proper handwashing steps before and after every meal, and make it a routine to brush your teeth twice a day.
